RECORDING SCOTTISH SILVER



Historically there are differences between English and Scottish practice regarding hallmarks.

When dealing with Scottish silver, recorders should refer to the Scottish section in the Introduction to Pocket Jackson's Hallmarks. This was written by Scottish silver expert Henry Steuart Fotheringham who also prepared the lists of Edinburgh, Glasgow and Provincial Makers' Marks.
