Where Activities involve third-party providers (including but not limited to restaurants, guides, transport providers, or venues), the Society accepts no responsibility for the acts, omissions, or performance of such third parties. The Society also accepts no liability for loss, theft, or damage to personal property.

By making a booking and submitting any required payment or deposit, the participant is deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions.

Refunds for cancellations will only be issued if another participant is able to take the vacated place.
