Whilst the exterior of this property is conventional the interior has a wealth of fascinating and unusual features. It was home to the surrealists Sir Roland Penrose and Lee Miller and their son Antony. It was also a meeting place for leading figures from the 20th century art world and their work is on display here. Overseas visitors included Pablo Picasso, Max Ernst, Joan Miró, Man Ray, Leonora Carrington and Dorothea Tanning.
