As we advised at our November meeting, the sale of Solberge Hall and proposed refurbishment means we will not be able to hold our lectures there in 2024.

The committee have considered alternate venues, and we are very excited to announce that **from January 2024**, we will move to **The Golden Lion, 114 High Street, Northallerton**.

Our lectures will be held in The Yorkshire Suite which is located at the rear of the hotel. It is a lovely big room (similar in size to Solberge) that can accommodate us comfortably. We have arranged with the Golden Lion that you will be able to book a sandwich lunch with cake and tea/coffee, that will be served at tables set out in the Yorkshire Suite; or you can have lunch in the dining room choosing from their regular menu.

Car parking in the hotel car park will be free for attendees at the lecture, this is available on a first-come, first-served basis. If the hotel car park is full, public parking is available on the High Street and there is a car park in Crosby Road, although these are not free.
