07/10/2024	Gabriel Chanan	<p><u>'The Wanderers'</u> The Wanderers was a movement of painters and others who rebelled against the neo-classical constraints of art in the Russian Empire, including Ukraine, in the 1860s. They sought to depict, for the first time, the real life of the majority of the population.</p>
04/11/2024	Anthony Peers	<p><u>The Triumph of Lutyens' New Delhi</u> This lecture gives consideration to the several styles of Indian architecture – not least the Mughal, before celebrating the masterpiece, and innovative stylistic triumph, that is New Delhi, designed by Edwin Lutyens.</p>
02/12/2024	Harry Venning	<p><u>The Art of the Cartoonist</u> Harry Venning has been a professional cartoonist for thirty years, during which time he has provided cartoons for several high-profile UK publications (The Guardian, Radio Times) as well as for countless more obscure titles (British Journal of Wound Care). Harry will be drawing live.</p>
03/02/2025	Pepe Martinez	<p><u>Banksy - Fraud or Genius</u> The lecture will trace the story of Banksy's humble beginnings as a tagger on the streets of Bristol in the 1980s to one of the most recognisable names in the art world.</p>
03/03/2025	Alexandra Epps	<p><u>Dress Code - Ten Iconic Dresses in Art</u> Ten iconic dresses within ten famous portraits from the nineteenth and twentieth centuries. Portraits that have shocked and delighted audiences in equal measure.</p>
07/04/2025	Caroline Shenton	<p><u>JMW Turner & the day Parliament burned down</u> In the early evening of 16 October 1834, to the horror of bystanders in London, a huge ball of fire exploded through the roof of the Houses of Parliament. 12/05/2025	Laurie Wickwire	<p><u>Carl Fabergé: Jeweller to the Tsars</u> Simply the word "Fabergé" conjures up images of jewelled art linked to Russian Royalty. This talk explores the relationship between a ruler and a jeweller.</p>
02/06/2025	Lois Oliver	<p><u>Rosa Bonheur (1822-1899): animal painter extraordinaire</u> One of the most celebrated artists of her time, French painter Rosa Bonheur had an extraordinary gift for painting animals that brought her international fame and recognition.</p>
07/07/2025	Simon Whitehouse	<p><u>The World's Greatest Paintings: 200 Years of the National Gallery</u> 2024 marked the bicentenary of the founding of the National Gallery. This lecture tells the story of the establishment of the NG collection.</p>
