Wednesday 4th October 2023: MEDIEVAL WINCHESTER

Winchester College and the Hospital of St Cross

We travel to Winchester for a guided tour of some of the College's principal buildings followed by a visit to The Treasury which houses the College's museum of art and archaeology. This will be followed by a pre-booked sandwich lunch at The Wykeham Arms after which the coach will take us to the Hospital of St Cross, one of England's oldest continuing almshouses, for a guided tour of this magnificent medieval community and church, concluding with tea and cake before the journey home.

The coach will leave Marlborough outside OneStop at 8.30, picking up others at the Bouverie Hall car park in Pewsey at 8.45ish. We will be dropped off outside the Guildhall in Winchester from where it is a 15 minute walk through the cathedral close to the College. The Wykeham Arms where we will have lunch is adjacent to the College, and then we return to where the coach dropped us off outside the Guildhall for 1.45pm and the very short journey out to St Cross. After our visit and tea there the coach will collect us for our return journey at 4.30, arriving in Pewsey at approximately 5.30, and Marlborough at about 5.45

The total cost of this visit is **£57** per head which includes guided tours at both venues, pre-booked sandwich lunch, tea and cake, and coach travel. As advised on the Society website, we will be sharing our visits this year with The Arts Society Kennet and Swindon (TASKS), giving a fortnight's priority to TASP members for the visits TASP organises. This visit will be opened up to TASKS members on September 20th so be sure to book early. The maximum number for this trip is 30.
