

## MARITIME MEMORIALS

**Information required:** anyone that died before 1914 unless there is a large and important Memorial. This covers all naval personnel and anyone with naval or shipping, shipbuilding connections, whether they died or were killed in service or died naturally in their beds. It should also include passengers that died in shipwrecks. Information is required of plaques, monuments and memorial windows but NOT other items eg silver or wooden items given in memory. Also include details of ships' bells and naval flags.
