Prasannajit de Silva: British Landscape Views of India

British artists first travelled to India in the mid-eighteenth century and views of the country remained a popular subject for numerous artists, professional and amateur, throughout the period of the Empire. Their work encompassed both India's natural scenery and its rich architectural heritage. After a brief introduction to the nature of British involvement in India, we will consider the work of artists who travelled to India in the late eighteenth century, including William Hodges and Thomas Daniell, whose paintings and prints of Indian scenes were hugely influential in shaping British understanding of Indian settings. We will then explore how depictions of landscapes evolved in the nineteenth century, with an increasing romanticism of Indian rural life, growing British scholarly interest in Indian architecture and archaeology and, from mid-century, the rapid growth in the use of photography. Through all this, we will consider some key questions. What was the appeal of this Indian material to a British audience? What were the issues facing artists from one culture engaged in portraying scenes from another? How was their work shaped by prevailing European aesthetic theories? And what was the impact back in Britain of the material they produced?
