

CHISWICK HOUSE & GARDENS VISIT - LONDON W4 2RP ON THURSDAY 16th MAY, 2019

Chiswick House was built in 1729 by Lord Burlington and subsequently inherited by the 6th Duke of Devonshire. The interiors are sumptuous, many designed by William Kent, with a superb collection of furniture and paintings, including a Rubens. Following the tour of the house we can stroll through the 19th century Italian Garden designed by the 6th Duke of Devonshire; the layout of the gardens was inspired by those of Ancient Rome. Highlights include the stunning Conservatory, home to the oldest collection of camellias in Britain and a walk around the walled kitchen garden, which will be open, is also recommended.

We will gather at the main reception of the house from 11.00 am as the tour starts promptly at 11.15 am. There will be a break of $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours for lunch at their excellent café – to book ahead: 020 8995 6356. The garden tour will commence at 2.00 pm taking roughly $1\frac{1}{2}$ hours. **The cost per person will be £25.00**, which will include a guidebook.

Please note, there is no wheelchair access in the house. If travelling by car, there is a large pay & display car park, by underground via the District Line to Turnham Green with a short ride on the E3 bus located just outside the station, or on the Overground from Clapham Junction to Chiswick, followed by a 10-minute walk.
