Moving us forward historically, we will have a guided tour of the brand new exhibition, Slavery Culture and Collecting. This exhibition details the slave owner and collector George Hibbert who was instrumental in building the West India Docks which now house the **Museum of London Docklands**. This connection positions the museum as an important place to think about the relationship between slavery and cultural heritage. The display contains a short film, as well as objects from the collection to encourage further debate around this challenging issue.

There will be time for lunch and a further look around inside before we start our next session, which will be OUTSIDE, where we will have a tour of around 90 minutes to see the regeneration of the area post 1950s.

The cost of the trip, which will include the executive coach, entry to the museum and guided tours will be  $\pounds 52.00$  per person. NOT included is the  $\pounds 2.00$  parking fee, OR food. (There is a cafe in the museum.) Time is short, so please book as soon as possible.
