The Royal Military College (RMC), was founded in 1801 and established in 1802 at Great Marlow and High Wycombe in Buckinghamshire, England, but moved in October 1812 to Sandhurst, Berkshire. It was a British Army military academy for training infantry and

cavalry officers of the British and Indian Armies.

We had such an enjoyable trip to Sandhurst in June 2023, with a wonderful tour of the College buildings, that we decided to apply again this year. We were lucky enough to be allocated tickets to the rehearsal of the August Commandant's Passing out Parade.



We have to leave Braywick Leisure Centre at the early time of 08.15am in order to reach Sandhurst between 09.30am- 10.00am. All guests have to be seated by 10.30am. The Parade steps off at 11.50am and ends at approximately 12.15pm. Guests are required to carry photographic identification with them at all times during the visit and may be asked to produce ID if requested.

The dress code for the event is smart casual. Suit/sports jacket for men, day dress or equivalent for women. It's not overly formal but there are no jeans, hooded sweatshirts or trainers allowed.

We have been given permission again to bring a picnic, which we will leave in the coach during the Parade. We can then eat it by the beautiful lake on the picnic benches afterwards or in an indoor location in the event of bad weather.
