

Visit to Whistler's Windows, Moreton Millhouse Cider/Clock Museum

Thursday 31st January 2019

Our winter visit is a short trip out to Moreton near Dorchester to see the striking glass windows in St Nicholas Church. War time bombing extensively damaged the church and the refurbishment resulted in 13 uniquely artistic engraved glass windows by Sir Laurence Whistler who is regarded as reviving glass engraving in the 20th century. The designs include Biblical symbols, Christmas lanterns, vines, medallions, candles, landscapes, stars, lightning, local scenes and much more.

We plan to arrive at 10:30am when the church warden will give us a short talk on the history of the Church and its windows before we are free to browse. A short distance from the church is the cemetery, where Lawrence of Arabia's grave can be found.

We will then have lunch at the Moreton Tearooms. Please choose your menu preference(s) from overleaf. *Payment for lunch to be made on the day directly to the Tearooms*.

After lunch we will make the short coach trip to the Millhouse Cider and Clock Museum to see the clock collection focusing on the "Golden Age" of clock making in Dorset and the history and artifacts of cider making. We will also sample different ciders before returning home, hopefully sober!

The cost of £26 includes church donation, entrance fee to Museum, coach journey and driver's tip.

The coach will leave Clarendon/Portarlington Road at 9:00am and Canford Cliffs at 9:10am.

We shall rejoin the coach at 3:00pm hoping to arrive back at +/- 4:00 pm.
